



Camp Safety Guide for Parents!

What Have We Done to Ensure Our Camp is Safe?

- 1> **Training** - All our Professors have received COVID Safety Training
- 2> **Cleaning** - Providing hand sanitiser for our Professor and all our equipment will be cleaned prior to the camp
- 3> **PPE** - Staff will wear a lab coat and be provided with full PPE equipment
- 4> **Social Distancing** - MNS are 'We're Good to Go, COVID-19 Certified' and will encourage children to maintain 1-2 metre safe social distancing.
- 5> **Activities** - We have adapted our fun camp activities to be COVID Safe
- 6> **Class Sizes** – Now limited to 15 children per class ('educational setting')

What Can You Do to Ensure Your Child is Safe at Camp

- 1> **Sanitise** – Before camp ensure your child has thoroughly washed their hands
- 2> **Collection Password** – Make sure that you, or any of your named collectors, remember the child 'collection password' you entered when booking online
- 3> **Transport** – Avoid travelling by public transport – try walking or cycling instead 😊
- 4> **Dropping Off** – Please observe social distancing when dropping off and collecting your child
- 5> **Child Items** – Please only send your child with coat, lunchbox, and water bottle, no toys please
